Text: Gandhi

Mahatma Gandhi (1869 - 1948). Born in India, Gandhi became famous as a leader in the independence of India from the British. He was a lawyer and a philosopher. He was very religious and believed in being pacific and non-violent. His way of getting publicity for his cause was by non-cooperation and by "passive resistance". His personal life was extremely simple. He ate very little and always dressed in a simple white cloth. He was not only a political leader but also a spiritual leader of India. This is why the Indians in Kipanga thought he was a saint and also why he refused to fight. Gandhi taught that fighting as a way of settling disagreement is bad. His attitude won Gandhi the respect of the whole world, but in 1948 just after India had become independent, Gandhi was assassinated by a fanatic in India. Many Indians live and work outside India. Many Indians are in Kenya and Tanzania, and used to live in Uganda.
